## APPELLATION

The Paso Robles American Viticultural Area (AVA) is located in San Luis Obispo County, CA. With 40,000 planted acres to wine grape vineyards, the area is known for big, full flavored red grape varietals including Zinfandel, Rhône-style wines and Cabernet Sauvignon.

## WINEMAKING NOTES

Harvested at night. Utilized a warm and extended fermentation, resulting in immense extraction of color and flavors. Wine was aged 11 months in French oak barrels, 50% new/50% seasoned before final blending and bottling.

## TASTING NOTES

Presents a deep ruby color and rich aromas of blackberry and dark chocolate, complemented by hints of vanilla and spice. On the palate, it offers a full-bodied, velvety texture with flavors of dark fruit, cassis, coffee, and leather, with lingering notes of black pepper and oak.
